

CHF Canada Operating Priorities (2008)

CHF Canada will continue to deliver a full program of work across all divisions and regions to serve and represent housing co-operatives and other members. We will place particular emphasis in 2008 on the following priorities:

- **participate in a multi-stakeholder campaign to reduce housing need in Canada, and seek support from government for more affordable housing in existing and new housing co-ops**
- **pursue the upload of the costs of Ontario's SHRA co-ops to the Ontario government, the transfer of program administration to the Agency for Co-operative Housing, and reform of the SHRA as it applies to the co-ops**
- **allocate new resources to good co-op management and governance, to help co-ops in difficulty and/or in receivership, and to reduce the risk of these outcomes for other co-ops**
- complete the delivery of all 2020 Vision tools planned for Phase 1 of the project
- **deliver interactive on-line education resources for co-ops and their managers**
- carry out a review of CHF Canada's governance including a consultative process among the leaders of the co-op housing movement
- **work with the Ontario government and our members to complete eviction law reform in the province**
- develop a leadership renewal program to engage the co-operative housing leaders of tomorrow and encourage emerging leadership from the full diversity of CHF Canada's membership

The priorities that are the responsibility of the Ontario Council are highlighted.
