We are going to offer this web forum again and, so that we can encourage as many staff as possible to participate in the discussion, we're going to hold the forum at two different times. We will have a morning session on Feb. 16th and an afternoon session on February 18th. Both of these sessions will present the same material, so you only need to participate in one of them.

Here's how easy it is to join the forum – you just call in to a conference call and log into a website at the same time and you'll be part of this discussion. You can watch the slide show unfold as you listen to Kathy from Morneau Sobeco explain the renewal presentation. You can also ask your questions throughout the presentation.

Here's how you participate:

1. Dial in to the meeting on your phone by using one of the following two phone numbers depending on where you are calling from:
 - Calling from Toronto - **(416) 342-1900**
 - Anywhere else in Canada - **(888) 882-9090**
2. Enter the **participant code – 1491622** followed by the pound key. Follow the instructions and you'll be placed into the conference call.
3. Then, on your computer, go to www.webconferencing.networktelsys.net
4. Enter your name, phone number, the conference reference code – **130627**, and the participant code from above – **1491622**.
5. Click on 'Conference' to enter the forum.
